Welcome! We love the sound of kids in our church.

Here are some ideas to keep them engaged:

- **Relax:** It's OK for kids to be kids.
- **Sit Close:** Consider sitting up front where it's easier for kids to see.
- **Explain:** Kids are curious! Explain what's happening in the service.
- **Participate:** Kids learn by mimicking what you do. So sing, pray, respond, etc.-kids will follow your lead.
- **Wander:** It's OK to move around in the back of the church or downstairs. Sometimes it's easier to let fidgety kids wander.
- **Need to Leave?:** No problem, but please come back! Sometimes kids just need a break.
- **Ask:** Questions or need help? Just ask our ushers.
